

COVID-19 Update

Skill at Arms – Information for visiting the range at these times.

In Preparation of your visit, please note that given the current Covid-19 situation, facilities at Redricks Lakes are closed (this includes toilets, café and changing rooms). Please also note that this is a private estate that is not open to the public. Access to the site is only available on the day if you have a prior booking for an activity.

If you or any member of your family have Covid-19 symptoms or have travelled abroad within the last 14 days, please do not come to the range.

Staying alert & safe

All shooters should keep two metres apart at all times whilst at the range, and keep to a maximum of one (1x) shooter per firing point.

Facemask, gloves & eye protection are a must

All shooters must wear an appropriate face mask, eye protection and gloves whilst on-site at Redricks Lakes. If you are attending an Air Rifle session and am using your own equipment, then gloves and masks are not compulsory, but eye protection is essential. Hand sanitiser and disinfectant wipes are available on site.

Spectators

Because of the current Covid-19 situation, no spectators are allowed on-site. If you have been driven to the venue by another member of your family, that person will need to remain in the car for the duration of your experience.

New address

We are now based at Redricks Lakes, Redricks Lane, Sawbridgeworth, Herts, CM21 0RL.

Please note that the postcode WILL NOT send you to the right place (it is the postcode for the whole lane)... If you are using Google or Waze, you can search for "Skill at Arms" and you will find us! If in doubt, follow down Redricks Lane until you see signs for 'Redricks Lakes' & 'Skill at Arms'. Our What3Words is dizzy.gazed.brick

Timings

Please ensure you arrive at your designated time. We would ask that you do not arrive early - there is no need to arrive 15 minutes early as indicated on the website or confirmation email during this time.

Footwear

Because we have moved to a new part of the site in order to adhere to social distancing measures, please ensure you bring sturdy footwear as the ground is slightly more uneven to what we are used to. Also please bare in mind if it has rained recently, as these are outdoor experiences and we won't cancel because the ground is a little wet!

Upon arrival

Drive down the track approximately 200 yards and on the right you will see a sign for Skill at Arms. Turn right and follow this track for another 250 yards. The track will snake, but keep following it and you will see the designated parking. Please park where indicated and remain in your car until an instructor comes to collect you.

There will be times when the gate entrance to Redricks Lakes will be locked to minimise the flow of visitors to the site. If you arrive at Redricks Lakes and the gate is locked, please park in the layby at the front of the farm, indicated with a sign. Please wait for an instructor who will come to the gate to let you in at your allotted time. Please do not call us in this scenario unless it gets to any later than 5 minutes past your allotted time.

Consent Form

Please ensure that you have your consent form with you to sign and hand in to your instructor in advance of the safety briefing. This will help to speed things up on the day. If you haven't got a consent form (will be emailed to you prior to your experience day), please let us know before your experience (if you text us to let us know, please ensure you leave your name and what experience you have booked & when as well).
